

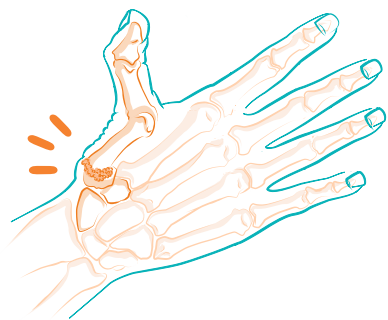
SYMPTOMS *that should alert you!*

WHAT SHOULD I DO?

Progressive hierarchy of solutions

1

Radiological examination

Determines whether you suffer from thumb osteoarthritis (rhizarthrosis) or another condition.

2

Medical treatment Helps relieve symptoms:

Painkillers
Anti-inflammatory medication
Night-time orthosis
Injection

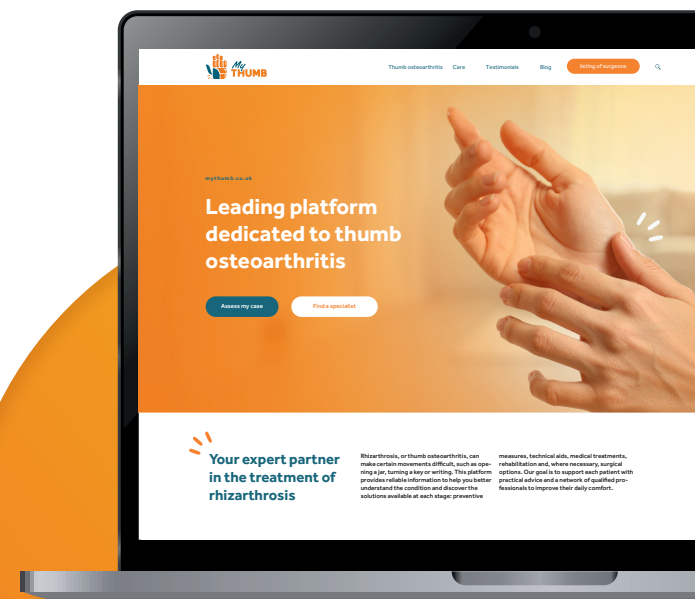
If medical treatment is insufficient and symptoms persist, **surgical intervention should be considered.**

3

Surgical treatment treats the joint deterioration in a long-lasting way.

Several procedures can be performed. Among them, implantation of a thumb prosthesis (*similar to a hip prosthesis, but miniaturized*).
